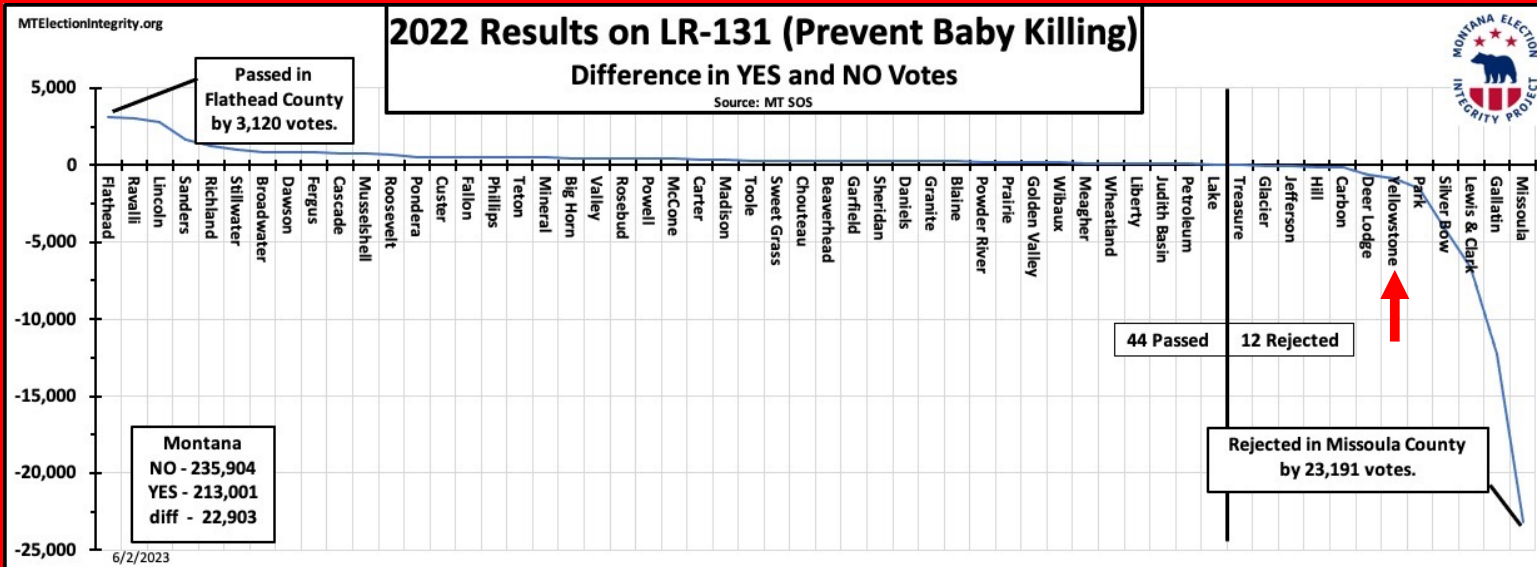
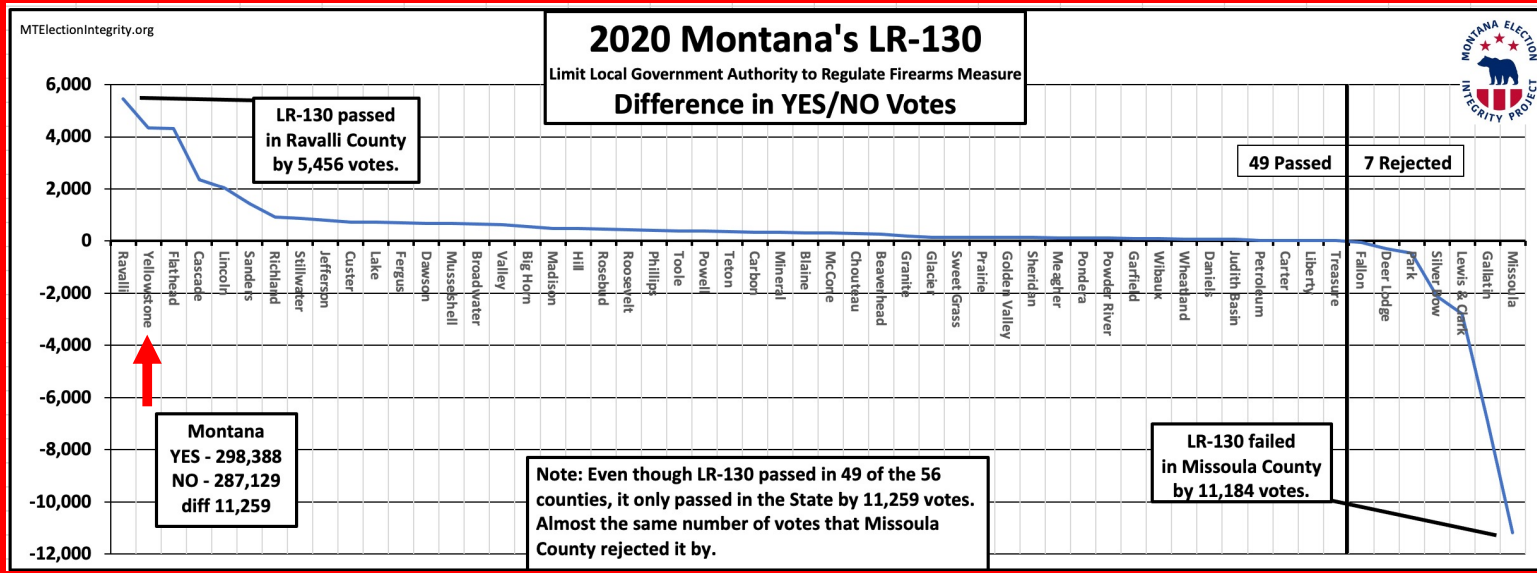


Are Machines & Inflated Voter Rolls Controlling MT Elections?

Gun Rights and Babies



Do These Results Make Sense?

- Gun rights (LR-131) passed in 2020, but by a narrow margin of **1.9%**, in the state with the highest per capita gun ownership. Yellowstone County had the second highest margin of support. Seven counties voted against gun rights.
- Born Alive Act (LR-131) was defeated in 2022 by **5.1%**, a greater margin than that of the gun rights. Twelve counties voted to kill babies including six of the seven that voted against gun rights. Yellowstone County switched from being very conservative on gun rights to being very liberal on a pro-life issue.
- Were these elections results generated by random human behavior, or by machines connected to the internet assisted by inflated voter rolls and mail-in voting? Could an algorithm have been used to manipulate the results to increase the margin between the two elections to ensure a desired outcome?
- What ballot issues or candidate races will be decided in a similar fashion in 2024, with no change to Montana's election infrastructure? Will ballot margin results increase artificially in the future until we are convinced that the values of Montanans have changed?
